Application <i>(one time)</i>	\$80	\$80	Processing of application and establishment of student record. Fee waived upon receiving courtesy unofficial evaluation
Enrollment Fee <i>(online course option)</i>	\$0*	\$0*	Official evaluation of transferred credits, academic advisement, and academic program planning for first year. * Students who do not complete the required number of Excelsior College course credits before graduation will be switched to the Multi-Source option and charged the veteran Multi-Source enrollment fee of \$740 or the civilian Multi-Source enrollment fee of \$1065.
Tuition <i>(per credit)</i>	\$380	\$465	Participation in academic coursework.
Student Services Annual Fee <i>(annual)</i>	\$0*	\$0**	Annual fee for ongoing academic advising and program planning, library, and student support services. This is paid on an annual basis with the first annual fee charged one year after enrollment. * Students enrolling as Veteran Partner Members who do not complete at least six (6) Excelsior College online course credits in one year will be charged a \$225 annual fee. ** Non-Partner students who do not complete at least twelve (12) Excelsior College online course credits in one year will be charged \$495.
Graduation Fee <i>(one time)</i>	\$130*	\$495	Final review and processing of student files for conferring of degree and issuance of diploma. * The Enrollment and Graduation Fees revert to the Non-Partner Rate if the student does not complete a minimum of twelve (12) Excelsior College online course credits prior to completion of a undergraduate degree program. In the event the Graduation Fee reverts to the Non-Partner Rate, this fee will be reduced by \$15 per academic credit for each undergraduate Excelsior College course successfully completed.

Master's Program

Application <i>(one time)</i>	\$100	\$100	Processing of application and establishment of student record. This fee is waived for all Excelsior alumni.
Graduate Student Services Annual Fee <i>(annual)</i>	\$265	\$265	Library services, academic advising, and academic program planning. This is paid on an annual basis with the first annual fee charged at time of enrollment.
Tuition <i>(per credit)</i>	\$505	\$595	Participation in academic coursework. There is a requirement of 12 credits prior to degree completion.
Graduation Fee <i>(one time)</i>	\$130	\$130	Final review and processing of student files for conferring of degree and issuance of diploma.

Undergraduate Certificate Programs

Application <i>(one time)</i>	\$50	\$50	Processing of application and establishment of student record.
Tuition <i>(per credit)</i>	\$380	\$465	Tuition per credit reverts to the standard rate if the student does not complete a minimum of twelve (12) Excelsior College course credits for a certificate program.

Application <i>(one time)</i>	\$50	\$50	Processing of application and establishment of student record.
Tuition <i>(per credit)</i>	\$505	\$595	Participation in academic coursework. There is a requirement of 12 credits prior to certificate completion.
Annual Fee	\$95	\$95	This is an annual fee for technology support.
